## Amendment No 2 to the Sailing Instructions

ITEM 1 - 16 TIME LIMITS SI 16.1 currently reads:

- **16.1** The following time limits will apply to each class, with the exception of the Nab Tower Race (Sponsored by Spirit Yachts), which will be 2000 for all classes and Long Inshore Race which will be 1800 for all classes.
  - (a) Mark 1 Time Limit. The time limit for the first boat in each class to pass Mark 1 is 60 minutes.
  - (b) Race Time Limit. The time limit for the first boat in each class to sail the course and finish is 210 minutes.
  - (c) Finishing Window. The time limit for boats to finish in each class after the first boat in that class sails the course and finishes is 60 minutes.

## And is now amended to read:

- **16.1** The following time limits will apply to each class, with the exception of the Nab Tower Race (Sponsored by Spirit Yachts), which will be 2000 for all classes and Long Inshore Race which will be 1800 for all classes.
  - (a) Mark 1 Time Limit. The time limit for the first boat in each class to pass Mark 1 is 60 minutes.
  - (b) Race Time Limit. The time limit for all boats in each class to sail the course and finish is 210 minutes.
  - (c) Finishing Window. If at least one boat from their class finishes within the Race Time Limit, the Race Time Limit is extended by 60 minutes.

ITEM 2

SI 3.4 is deleted.

## Competitor's attention is drawn to SI 6.4 which reads:

"Skippers' Briefings will take place in the BCYC Lounge at times shown on the Race Schedule. The skipper and/or the navigator from each yacht shall attend. [DP] "
