Amendment No 2 to the Sailing Instructions

Affecting the Household Division Yacht Club Regatta

Saturday 24 July 2021



The Princess Elizabeth Cup



The Princess Elizabeth Cup (PEC) will be raced for by the regiments of the Household Division in J70s on 24th July 2021, as part of the Household Division Yacht Club Regatta.

1. Eligibility for The PEC is as follows:
 - a. Each boat shall represent a regiment.
 - b. Each boat shall have at least two people from the regiment it is representing on-board, these people must be serving or recently retired (for less than 5 years unless by prior agreement with the Race Committee and all skippers).
 - c. Each boat must be helmed by one of the people described in sub para b above.
 - d. Boats that are ineligible for the PEC due to sub paras a, b & c above may take part.
2. Spinnakers will not be used in this competition.
3. The competition will consist of a number of short races from a committee Vessel start and finish line. One race will be required to constitute the regatta and when 4 or more races are completed 1 race may be discarded. The Race Committee may alter the number of races sailed according to weather or other circumstances.
4. The last finish of the day for the PEC may be on the RYS finish line.
5. There will be a briefing for all competitors at 1000 on the day of the regatta on the RYS Lawn immediately beyond The Lodge.
6. The race area is likely to be in either Osborne or Thorness Bays
