SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Amendment Number One

1. Add to SIs 10.1 the following: This will not be grounds for redress and changes RRS 62.1.
2. Replace SIs 6.2 with the following:

6.2 Teams will be identified either by their Club Bib, or by a Lettered Bib supplied by the OA. See SIs Addendum G Race Schedule. The Bib, worn by the helm, shall be visible to an umpire and the RC at all times.
3. Add after SIs 10.6:

10.7 Breakdowns will fall into two categories:
(a) Those that can be repaired under 5 minutes – Category 1;
(b) Those that take longer – Category 2.

10.8 Category 1 Breakdowns.
(a) Racing will be delayed and Postponement Flag AP will be displayed

10.9 One Category 2 Breakdown:
(a) The broken down boat will be removed from the racing area until repairs have been completed;
(b) Addendum G Race Schedule will continue as normal, except that one of the teams will sail boats with two different flags colours:
 - o Example: Red Boat suffers a Category 2 Breakdown;
 - o Team X is to change into the Red boats for the next race when they will be sailing against Team Y in the Yellow Boats;
 - o One Team X crew will change into the Red boat, while the other crew must wait until the previous race is finished, and then change into a Blue boat.
 - o The race will then be between Team Y in 2 Yellow boats against Team X in a Red Boat and a Blue boat.

(c) In the race the umpires will indicate which boat is to be penalized by displaying the colour of the boat;

(d) At the Warning Signal, Team flags Red and Yellow will be displayed.

10.10 Two Category 2 Breakdowns:
(a) If this occurs in one set of boats ... there will be a double change-over in that fleet;
(b) If there is one breakdown in both Course fleets then both fleets will operate as above.

10.11 Three or four Category 2 Breakdowns:
(a) The boats will be reassigned so that each fleet operates with a minimum of four boats.
4. Replace SI 17.1 with the following:

17.1 The VHF Channels that will be used for communications will be as follows:
(e) Course 1 Umpires: S1
(f) Course 2 Umpires: S2
(g) ROs & RYS Ribs: S3.
5. Add to SIs Addendum C3.14 the following: This will not be grounds for redress and changes RRS 62.1.

5. Replace SIs Addendum E with the following:
