REGATTA SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Organising Authority Royal Yacht Squadron

1. APPLICABLE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1.1. The Sailing Instructions for this Regatta, as required by RRS 90.2, are constituted by these RSIs in conjunction with the RYS SSIs, which may be found on the RYS Website.

- 1.2. The Event will be governed by:
 - (a) the 'rules' as defined in the RRS, including Appendix C.
 - (b) the rules for Handling Boats (SI Addendum C) which also applies to any practice sailing and sponsor races. Class rules will not apply.
 - (c) any prescriptions of the national authority that will apply will be posted on the official notice board.
- 1.4. Add to RRS 41: (e) help to recover from the water and return on board a crew member, provided the return on board is at the approximate location of the recovery.
- 1.5. Add after the first sentence of Appendix A5 'When one of the boats in a match fails to sail the course in accordance with rule 28.1, she shall be scored DNF without a hearing.'
- 1.6. Delete RRS C6.3 and replace with: A boat intending to request redress because of circumstances that arise while she is racing or in the finishing area, shall clearly display a red flag as soon as possible after she becomes aware of those circumstances, but no later than two minutes after finishing or retiring.
- 1.7. When the umpires proceed under RRS C8.6 they will follow the guidance in SI Addendum E.

2. REGATTA OFFICE

- 2.1. The Regatta Office is located in the RYS Container, Shepards Wharf Marina.
- 2.2. The ONB is located in the RYS Container.

3. BOATS AND SAILS

- 3.1. The J70 to be sailed, and the sails to be used, which may include symmetrical spinnakers, will be provided by the OA, and allocated by the RC.
- 3.2. The RC may require boats to reef their mainsails, in which case boats will be informed by the umpires.
- 3.3. The use of the spinnakers may be restricted by the RC in response to the prevailing conditions.
- 3.4. Other restrictions or instructions may be given to the boats verbally by an umpire. Code Flag L is not required.

4. ELIGIBILITY and CREW NUMBERS

- 4.1. Each team shall be comprised of two crews of four persons in each boat.
- 4.2. Teams may consist either of any category of member of the Royal Yacht Squadron (RYS), including those participating in Squadron Sailing Associate Programme, or of members of the Royal Navy Sailing Association (RNSA).
- 4.3. To remain eligible each crew shall complete Registration, and lodge the Sailing Agreement. All Skippers shall sign the Disclaimer before going to sea.
- 4.4. Each skipper shall be responsible for the damage or loss to their boat and supplied equipment unless responsibility is otherwise assigned by the umpires or PC.

5. IDENTIFICATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF BOATS

5.1. Each team will be identified by a bib – details to be briefed before racing commences.

6. ENTRIES and ELIGIBILITY

- 6.1. To remain eligible the entire crew shall complete registration, pay any entry fee and a deposit for damage.
- 6.2. The damage deposit is the limit of liability of each skipper for each incident. In the event that a deduction is made from the deposit, the skipper will be required to restore the deposit to the original value to maintain eligibility.
- 6.3. Each skipper is responsible for the damage or loss to their boat unless responsibility is otherwise assigned by the umpires or PC.
- 6.4. After the warning signal for a match, the registered skipper shall not leave the helm, except in an emergency.

7. COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 7.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the RYS Container, Shepards Wharf.
- 7.2. Skippers shall attend the first briefing with the Race Officer and Umpires, which will be at 0830 in Shepards Wharf, unless excused by the OA.

7.3. The RC will communicate any on the water amendments via the Umpires.

8. RACE AREA

8.1. Racing will take place from a Committee Vessel in the Solent, which is likely to be anchored in Osborne Bay.

9. REGATTA PROGRAMME, FORMAT AND TIMINGS

- 9.1. See Addendum A.
- 9.2. There will be a round robin of 16 races. Then, time allowing, semi-finals between the top four teams (first races fourth, second races third) and then a final. The number of races for the seni-finals and finals will be decided by the RC depending on remaining sailing time.
- 9.3. Each subsequent race will be started as soon as practicable after the previous race. Boats are advised to stay close to the CV after finishing / retiring.

10. COURSE

- 10.1. All races will be conducted on Course Configuration A, SSIs 9.2.
- 10.2. Note the Definition in SSIs C1.2.
